Students develop 21st century skills in a rigorous, inquiry-based program that engages them in their own learning and helps them make sense of the world around them through first-hand experience and independent observation. Students explore six transdisciplinary themes, spread across the content areas of language arts, social studies, math, science, arts, and physical education: *who we are, where we are in place and time, how we express ourselves, how the world works, how we organize ourselves, and sharing the planet*. An integral part of this magnet program is the acquisition of French as a second language. Through second language acquisition, students will become more aware of diverse cultures and will develop not only a global awareness but also an “international mindedness” that promotes global citizenship.
